Each qualified horse/pony will receive a qualification card in the ring which will enable the owner to enter the Championship Show, provided the owner and rider/handler are, or become registered with the Concours D'Elegance Society within 21 days of the qualifying show. No horse registration is required.

Day Rate £25 (For members only)

This entitles a horse and rider combination to enter any 4 classes.

Additional classes can be entered at the correct rate. Please see above for jumping rules.

A competitor must compete as a combination at least four times in each class to be eligible for trophies.

Lead Rein Competitors

PLEASE NOTE: As a Club we will be allowing LR ponies to compete at 13.2hh. Please be aware that most affiliations require LR ponies to be 12.2hh and under. Please see relevant affiliation websites for further details.

Points system:

1st - 7 points, 2nd - 6 points, 3rd - 5 points, 4th - 4 points, 5th - 3 points, 6th - 2 point.

Lead Rein Competitors are allowed in all classes except for classes 3,4 & 6,7 & 14

Competitors in classes 46/47 are for genuine novices who need assistance and are not permitted to enter classes 48-53

A pony is not allowed in this section twice.
