Class 50: 50cm Beginners Horses and Ponies  
Class 51: 60cm Horses and Ponies (ESUK)  
Class 52: 65cm Horses and Ponies (ESUK)  
Class 53: 70cm Horses and Ponies (ESUK)  
Class 54: 80cm Horses and Ponies (ESUK)  
Class 55: 90cm Horses and Ponies (ESUK)  
Class 56: Higher and Higher—proposed

**Competitors in classes 46/47 are for genuine novices who need assistance and are not permitted to enter classes 48-53**

**Competitors may only compete in 2 Consecutive height jumping classes.**  
**Class 54 is open to all competitors excluding lead rein.**

**Day Rate £25 ( For members only)**

This entitles a horse and rider combination to enter any 4 classes.  
Additional classes can be entered at the correct rate. Please see above for jumping rules.

**A competitor must compete as a combination at least four times in each class to be eligible for trophies.**

### Lead Rein Competitors

**PLEASE NOTE: As a Club we will be allowing LR ponies to compete at 13.2hh. Please be aware that most affiliations require LR ponies to be 12.2hh and under. Please see relevant affiliation websites for further details.**

### Points system:

1st - 7 points, 2nd - 6 points, 3rd - 5 points, 4th - 4 points, 5th - 3 points, 6th - 2 point.
